



P: Remember not the sins of my youth or my transgressions;


C: According to your steadfast love remember me, for the sake of your goodness, O LORD!



P: All the paths of the LORD are steadfast love and faithfulness, for those who keep his covenant and his testimonies.














The Prayer of the Day

C: Amen.


The Epistle Lesson: 1 John 4:7-12

The Gospel Lesson: Mark 9:2-9

- The Holy Gospel according to St. Mark, the ninth chapter.

C: In your mercy, hear us, accept our prayers and be with us always. Amen.

The Benediction



St. James Is Participating in "40 Days for Life" and We Need Your Participation

Are you willing to pray for one hour to end abortion? 40 Days for Life is a pro-life effort that consists of 40 days of praying, fasting, and holding a peaceful vigil in front of an abortion facility. This will be the 23rd campaign in Grand Rapids and will **take place in front of Heritage Clinic for Women at 320 East Fulton Street**. This is the only free-standing surgical abortion facility still operating in our community. **St. James has adopted Saturday, February 20, from 1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. to pray at the peaceful vigil.** We require at least 2 people per hour time slot to be present in front of the abortion facility praying.
