Bible Study 3: Giving Our Team Our Best

The sports world is filled with cliches. In this Bible study we are going to discuss some of these sports cliches as they relate to our lives as teammates on God's winning team. I have provided some Bible passages to stimulate and guide our discussion.

Cliché #1: "She's a gym rat." What does a "gym rat" look like on God's team? Who do you think of as a "gym rat" in the Bible? Today?

Cliché #2: "He's a workhorse." What's a "workhorse" look like on God's team? What are the pros and cons of a "workhorse?"
